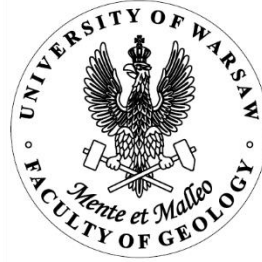

- active participation in research and scientific projects,
- active participation in scientific conferences,
- fluent of Polish and English,
- didactic experience in conducting classes in the field of hydrogeology, geophysics, including field classes,
- experience in applying GIS programs in geology, ability to work in a team.

Basic duties:

- conducting lectures and field classes, including hydrogeology and geophysics,
- readiness to conduct independent lectures and seminars, including the application of GIS programs in geology,
- undertaking initiatives in the field of innovation in the teaching proces,
- development of research in their field of interest,
- publishing and conference activity,
- commitment to fundraising for research,
- involvement in the organizational work of the Faculty of Geology, and the Department of Hydrogeology and Geophysics.

The candidates should submit:

1. application addressed to the Rector of the University of Warsaw containing consent "I give permission to the University of Warsaw, registered at the address of ul. Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, 00-927 Warszawa, to process my personal data for the purposes of carrying out the recruitment procedure, choosing the employee, and entering into an employment contract with the University of Warsaw, if applicable. I have been informed about my legal rights and obligations in relation to these actions. I acknowledge that providing the aforementioned personal data is done by me on a voluntary basis. "
2. a diploma or equivalent document confirming the achievement of a degree;
3. opinion of an independent researcher;
4. list of publications;
5. information about previous employment;
6. motivation letter;
7. a statement in which the candidate confirms that he has read and accepts the rules for conducting competitions for the position of academic teacher, made available on the website of the Faculty of Geology of the University of Warsaw

The person selected in the competition will be employed on the basis of a full-time employment contract for a specified period. Documents should be submitted to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Geology, University of Warsaw (Warsaw, Żwirki i Wigury 93, room P 003).

Application deadline: September 14, 2022

Applications will be considered by the Faculty Admissions Committee. The Faculty reserves the right to answer only selected offers and to close the competition without selecting a candidate. The competition will be resolved by October 30, 2022. The competition is the first stage of the procedure of employing academic teachers, as defined in the Statute of the University of Warsaw. Its positive result will initiate the next stages of employee procedures. Only candidates who meet the conditions set out in the Law on Higher Education and Science, Journal of Laws No. 2022 no 574.
