<p>Conditions for entering the competition³</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fulfillment of the requirements specified in art. 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws 2024, item 1571 consolidated text) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Phd. in Earth and related environmental sciences or biological sciences; – At least one completed stage of education (bachelor's degree; engineering degree or master's degree) documented by a diploma in the field of geology, prospecting geology or applied geology. – Field experience in geological research; – Scientific achievements in sedimentology, and/or stratigraphy, and/or, petrology, and/or, palaeontology, documented by publications and other scientific achievements; – Teaching experience in geology; – Knowledge of Polish and English sufficient for teaching; – Foreigners: documented (e.g. certificates, etc.) knowledge of Polish at a level sufficient to conduct academic classes in the field of geology – International experience in scientific research; – Plan for further research activities.
